

Via Brigitta - A way back to the future

As part of the Festival of Young Talents at the Kunstverein Frankfurt, the Via Brigitta collective ventures a look over the site fences of Frankfurt's new old town and offers guided tours around the old town centre.

After years of standstill and costly open-heart operations by the architects and construction managers of DomRömer GmbH, the public is now eagerly awaiting the first impulses that will make the heart of Frankfurt's Old Town beat again. When the 12-year construction and planning period ends in September 2018, it will be up to the citizens of the city of Frankfurt to revive the new centre. The paths in front of the fences still come to an end, but from the 3rd to 6th of May you can take a first look at the almost pulsating heart. During this period, the collective offers guided tours of the old town - on ladders - around the existing construction site.

Climb up and look at the familiar, the revived and the rediscovered. For example, you will encounter the historic Brigitta Fastrada, which in 794 AD had a strong influence on the Frankish Empire and formed Frankfurt's multicultural identity, which can still serve as a model today.

The project is part of the Festival of Young Talents at the Kunstverein Frankfurt. The opening hours of the Kunstverein are daily from 14.00 to 22.00 o'clock and on the 5th of May until 2:00 o'clock (Night of the Museums).
